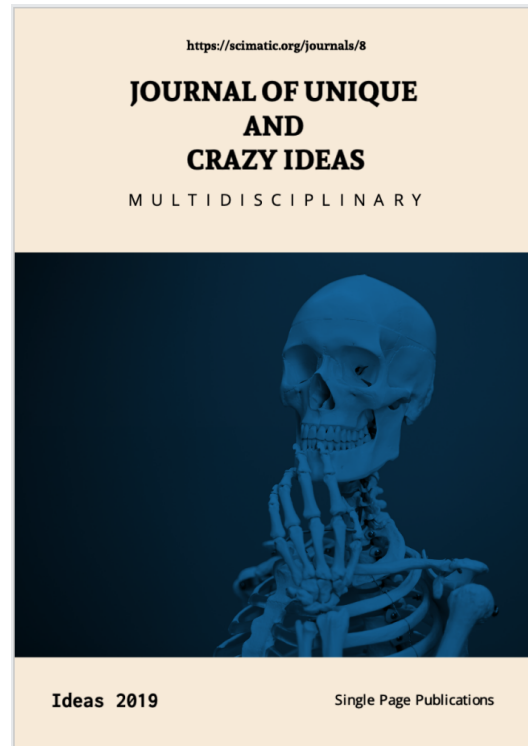

IDEA
